



Mennonite Sale Nets \$21,182.24

The 19th Annual Mennonite Relief Sale held last weekend at the Arthur Fairgrounds fell short of last year's \$23,500, but still netted \$21,182.24.

Four-hundred persons registered for the auction Saturday morning.

Some of the larger items such as an oak hutch sold for \$600, a grandmother clock sold for \$725, and quilts ranged to more than \$300.
